FREE PHOTO EDITING APPS FOR ANDROID AND IOS

SNAPSEED

A powerful and fully free editing app by Google. It offers professionallevel tools like brightness, contrast, sharpness, selective adjustments, healing (to remove small objects), and filters like HDR and vintage effects.

No paid version needed!

LIGHTROOM MOBILE

It offers basic editing tools like exposure, contrast, highlights, shadows, and color adjustments. The FREE version has limited functions, but they are enough for basic editing.

VSCO

Includes a limited set of stylish filters and basic editing tools (exposure, contrast, saturation, and sharpness). The free version has fewer filters compared to the paid subscription but is still great for achieving a creative look.

CANVA

A versatile design app, great for content creation, that can also be used as a photo and video editing tool.

It has a free version and a Paid one, that gives access to more tools.



- **Healing Tool:** Remove unwanted objects or blemishes seamlessly.
- **Filters and Presets:** Apply a variety of artistic and corrective filters.
- **RAW Support:** Edit RAW files for higher-quality images.
- **User-Friendly Interface:** Easy navigation with responsive touch controls.







- Camera Integration: Capture photos directly within the app for seamless editing.





ACTIVITY 5.1.1

Editing photos on your smartphone



ESSENTIAL PHOTO EDITS

1. Light and Exposure

- Adjust Brightness to lighten/darken the photo
- Modify Highlights and Shadows for balanced lightning
- Use Contrast to make details pop


2. Color & Tone

- Adjust White Balance to do basic colour corrections on TEMP and TINT, as well as SATURATION
- Then you can go to Colour MIX (in Lightroom) and adjust specific colors
- Apply Filters for a quick style change

3. Sharpness & Details

- Use Sharpening & Clarity to enhance textures
- Crop & Straighten for better composition







FREE VIDEO EDITING APPS FOR ANDROID AND IOS

CAPCUT

CapCut is a free, all-in-one video editor developed by the creators of TikTok (ByteDance). It's designed for fast, intuitive editing and creating engaging short-form content.

INSTAGRAM'S BUILT-IN VIDEO EDITOR

Instagram has a built-in video editor for posts, Stories, and Reels. It's simple but optimized for the platform, making it easy to create engaging content without leaving the app.

INSHOT


InShot is a user-friendly editing app designed for quick and polished videos, especially for Instagram Reels, TikToks, and Facebook stories. It's particularly effective for trimming, merging, and adding creative elements to short videos.

CANVA (VIDEO EDITOR)

Canva isn't just for graphics — it also has an excellent video editor. It's ideal for creating visually appealing videos with text, templates, and animations.





- Free version comes with ads and watermarks when exporting

INSTAGRAM'S BUILT-IN VIDEO EDITOR







Canva's template-based editing allows even complete beginners to create professional-looking videos, perfect for social media posts, stories, or reels.









ACTIVITY 5.2.1

Editing videos on your smartphone



ESSENTIAL VIDEO EDITS

1. Trim, cut and adjust

- Trim clips to remove unwanted parts
- Split longer videos into shorter segments
- Rearrange clips for better storytelling


2. Add Music or voice over

- Add Music to set the mood, choose from the app's available music for better integration (some apps might delete your music if it is not accessible on their platform)
- Add voiceover to enhance the storytelling and give it a personal touch

3. Enhance Look & Feel

- Apply Filters for consistent style
- Choose the Right Aspect Ratio (9:16 for Stories/Reels, 1:1 for IG Feed)

ACTIVITY 5.3

Advanced Editing Techniques



ADVANCED PHOTO EDITS

1. Color Grading

- Adjust Hue, Saturation &
 Temperature for mood
- Use Presets (VSCO, Lightroom) for consistency
- Keep colors natural avoid overediting


2. Spot Healing & Object Removal

- Remove spots or distracting objects (Snapseed's Healing Tool).
- Perfect for product photography or portraits where the background needs to be clean.

3.Selective Adjustments

- Brighten or darken only specific areas (faces, products, skies).
- Snapseed: Selective Tool → Tap area →
 Adjust brightness/contrast/saturation.
- Helps guide the viewer's eye to the main subject.





ADVANCED PHOTO EDITS

4. Perspective & Geometry Corrections

- Fix tilted horizons or distorted buildings (Lightroom → Geometry tool).
- Useful for architectural shots or flat lays that look "crooked."

5.Creative Effects & Styling

- Add vignette for dramatic focus on the subject.
- Experiment with double exposure (Snapseed) for storytelling visuals.
- Turn photos black & white and selectively keep one color (color splash effect).



Pro Tip: Combine subtle adjustments + creative effects instead of doing everything at once — less is more for a professional look.



ADVANCED VIDEO EDITS

1. Color Grading

- Adjust Brightness/Exposure to avoid over- or under-lit videos
- Use Contrast to make details pop
- Correct White Balance (too warm
 yellow, too cool = blue) for natural tones
- CapCut/InShot: Choose filters for mood (warm, vintage, cool)
- Reduce saturation for a soft, cinematic look

2. Text Animations & Captions

- Add Animated Text for intros or key points (CapCut, InShot, Canva)
- Use Captions for accessibility & engagement
- Match font style & colors with your brand or theme





ADVANCED VIDEO EDITS


3. Special Effects


- Slow Motion: Highlight key actions or emotional moments
- Speed Up: Make tutorials or processes more dynamic
- Masking / Overlays: Blend clips or add creative cutouts (CapCut advanced feature)

Pro Tip:

- Always color correct (fix exposure & white balance) before creative grading
- Keep a consistent look across clips for smoother storytelling
- Use effects sparingly too many distract from your story










ACTIVITY 5.4

Tips for Efficient Editing Workflow



TIPS&TRICKS: 1. Organize Your Files

- Create separate albums/folders for projects on your phone
- Name files clearly (e.g., IGreel_food1, FB_eventphoto2)
- Delete duplicates to save storage space


2. Use Templates & Presets

- Video: Canva & CapCut → Ready-made templates for IG Reels, Stories, TikTok
- Photo: Lightroom, VSCO → Apply presets for consistent style
- Save your favorite styles for reuse

3. Batch Editing

- Edit one photo → Apply same settings to multiple images (Lightroom, VSCO)
- Use CapCut templates to apply the same look to several videos
- Saves time + keeps visual identity consistent







DISCUSSION

- Discuss about the importance of setting a clear goal before starting to edit to avoid wasting time
- Ask participants to share their biggest challenges in editing workflow
- Brainstorm solutions together





ACTIVITY 5.5

Sharing and Exporting Edited Content



TIPS&TRICKS:

VIDEOS

- Export in 1080p (Full HD) → best balance of quality
 & upload speed
- Use 60 fps for smooth motion (TikTok & Reels love this)
- Keep file size under 100 MB per minute for fast uploads
- Choose MP4 (H.264 codec) → most social platforms prefer it
- Check Aspect Ratios:

IG Reels / TikTok / Stories → 9:16 (vertical)

IG Feed → 1:1 (square) or 4:5 (portrait)

Facebook → 16:9 (horizontal) or 1:1

PHOTOS

- Export in JPEG or PNG (both work well for social)
- Resolution: at least 1080x566 px for IG feed, 1080 x 1920 px for Stories/Reels
- Keep file size under 2 MB (Snapseed/Lightroom settings let you reduce file size without quality loss)
- Maintain same color profile (sRGB) to avoid color shifts online

Pro Tips:

- Export and upload directly on the preferred platform (avoid sending via WhatsApp/email, as they compress files)
- Use Wi-Fi when uploading high-res videos/photos to avoid auto-compression by the platform





TIPS&TRICKS:



INSTAGRAM & FACEBOOK

Photos: Landscape: 1080x566/

Vertical: 1080x1350 (1012x1350 in Grid view)

- Stories/Reels: 1080x1920px (1082x1440 (3:4) in Grid view)
- 30fps, vertical format preferred.

TIK-TOK

• Photos: Landscape: 1920x1080/

Vertical: 1080x1920

• Stories/Reels: 1080x1920px

• 30fps, vertical format preferred.

App-Specific Tips:

- CapCut/InShot: Always select 1080p, 60fps, High Quality before exporting
- Canva: Download in MP4 (video) or PNG/JPEG (photo) with "High Quality" checked
- Snapseed/Lightroom: Export photos at highest resolution → adjust file size only if upload is too slow
- Instagram Editor: Avoid heavy compression → edit outside IG first, then upload





FINAL TASK AND DISCUSSION

 Participants are split in small groups and they have to create a short 30 sec video or a series of 3-5 photos. The content could have different themes which are up to the participants.
